

“2018 Illinois Stallion Stakes”

**To be raced Sunday, August 5, 2018
at the Brown County Fair, Mt. Sterling, Illinois
Post Time 2:00 PM
Estimated Purses: \$12,000 per division**

These Stake races are for two-year-olds that are Illinois conceived and foaled and registered with the Illinois Department of Agriculture and sired by stallions that were nominated in 2018 to the Illinois Stallion Stakes.

The 2016 foals from the following Illinois stallions have been nominated to compete in the 2018 Illinois Stallion Stakes:

NEW OPTION - LATE SUPPLEMENT: *New this year, for an eligible foal whose sire was not nominated in the above list, the foal will be allowed to race IF the foal’s owner pays the corresponding nomination fee at the time of entry. To be clear, ONLY that one foal will be allowed to race IF the correct nomination amount is paid for that stallion as a late supplement. For example:*

The Illinois-certified stallion, IMASTALLION, has three eligible foals, IMAFOAL1, IMAFOAL2 and IMAFOAL3. For 1-10 foals the nomination fee is \$250 and all three foals may race. If the owner of IMASTALLION does not pay the nomination fee of \$250, then the owner of IMAFOAL1 could pay \$250 and it would be allowed to race. IMAFOAL2 and IMAFOAL3, also eligible foals of IMASTALLION, would NOT be allowed to race unless each of their owners also paid \$250. ALL late supplement payments would be added to the purse.

Late Supplement Fees Based on # of eligible foals per Stallion:

1 - 10 Foals	\$ 250.00
11 - 25 Foals	\$ 500.00
26 - 50 Foals	\$ 750.00
51 and Up	\$1,000.00
